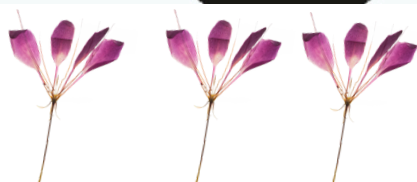

On Sept 12th we need volunteers to help run the sale (you get a free pancake ticket)

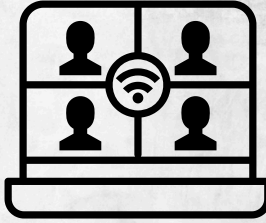
